## Annex 1: Groups for potential inclusion

As noted in the 'Scope' section, the following are indicative of potential groups for inclusion. This is not an exhaustive list.

- Families broadly defined as experiencing vulnerabilities or risk factors for poor health and social outcomes:
  - children in households where an adult has:
    - a drug or alcohol dependence
    - experienced violence or abuse from a partner in the last year
    - a clinically diagnosable mental health condition
  - o children with serious/long-term illness
  - children with substantial absence from school, or transient lifestyles that may challenge a good education
  - those suffering multiple disadvantages.
- Children supported by the child welfare system
- Looked after children
- Gypsy and traveller families
- Homeless families
- Children with learning disabilities
- Migrant, refugee and asylum-seeking families
