Addendum to HEIF policies and priorities: spin-outs best practice and adoption

Dear Vice-Chancellor or Principal

 This circular letter formalises our expectations on higher education providers (HEPs) to consider the best practices identified in the <u>Independent Review of University Spinouts</u> and to inform us of their adoption of these practices, which is voluntary, and provides first information on HEPs that have adopted to date.

Background

- 2. This circular letter follows <u>RE-CL-2024-02</u>, which set out our plan to implement the actions falling to Research England from the review, including implementation of our monitoring of adoption of best practice. An important principle to the review was transparency, and we committed to publishing a rolling list of adopting institutions on the HEIF accountability webpage, including HEP weblinks with details of associated institutional policy changes.
- 3. It also follows communication to HEPs on 10 May sent from <u>KEPolicy@re.ukri.org</u> on how to notify us of adoption via a survey accessed through the Research England Data Portal.
- This communication is relevant to all HEPs eligible for Research England knowledge exchange funding, including the Higher Education Innovation Funding. It forms an Addendum to "Higher Education Innovation Funding (HEIF) policies and priorities: accountability statements" (<u>RE-P-2020-03</u>).



- 5. It is of particular interest to research-intensive universities that produce spin-out companies, reflecting an expectation that these institutions agree to adopt the best practice policies set out in this document by the end of 2024.
- 6. It is also of particular interest to HEPs who have been successful in gaining CCF-RED shared tech transfer function pilot awards, as adoption of these best practices is a condition of their award.

Expectations on best practice

- 7. We expect HEPs to whom it is relevant (who are spinning out) to take account of the following best-practice documents in determining their policies and approaches to spin-out companies:
 - The report of the <u>Independent Review of University Spin-outs</u>, specifically Recommendation 1.
 - <u>TenU's USIT Guide</u> (University spin-out investment terms).
 - <u>TenU's USIT for Software Guide</u> (University spin-out investment terms).

First adoption list

8. The list of HEPs that have adopted best practices by 13 September 2024 is attached in the annex of this document.

Next steps

- We plan to update "Higher Education Innovation Funding (HEIF) policies and priorities: accountability statements" (<u>RE-P-2020-03</u>) in 2025, leading into the next round of HEIF accountability statements. We expect to embed the requirements on both spinout best practice (this Addendum) and on KE data collection (Addendum <u>RE-CL-2024-05</u>) in this next iteration of HEIF policies and priorities.
- 10. We are aware of many universities still undergoing a review of their policies in response to the independent review. We are committed to publishing an updated adoption list periodically. We expect to publish the next list on 21 November 2024 to mark a year since the spin-outs review report was published.
- 11.We expect to review our overall progress in implementing the review with Government at the end of 2024.
