Award of call-off Contract for the supply of services in relation to decarbonisation and carbon advisory as defined in Annex 1 work under framework agreement dated 27 June 2022 made between Ove Arup & Partners Limited (the "Supplier") and United Kingdom Research and Innovation ("UKRI") (the "Agreement")

In the event of any conflict between the provisions of the Agreement and those of the Contract, the provisions of the Contract will prevail.

The Contract and the Agreement are the entire basis on which UKRI proposes to contract with the Supplier. Please do not attach any Supplier terms and conditions to this Award Letter as they will not be accepted by UKRI and may delay conclusion of the Contract.

For the purposes of the Contract, UKRI and the Supplier agree as follows:

Term

- 1 Contract Commencement Date: 26th August 2024
- 2 Contract Expiry Date: 31st January 2025
- 3 UKRI may extend this Agreement for a period of up to 12 months by giving not less than 1 month notice in writing to the Supplier prior to the Contract Expiry Date. The terms and conditions of this Agreement shall apply throughout any such extended period.

Annex 1 – The Specification

Annex 1.1 - UKRI/STFC Requirements

Background:

UK Research and Innovation (UKRI) has made a commitment to achieve their Net Zero target by 2040; it is recognised that building a culture of sustainability in science and research will be crucial to reducing the carbon footprint of UKRI and the related research councils.

STFC undertakes research that supports the transition and the solutions to net zero i.e. carbon capture and storage, energy transition, net zero carbon and the mitigation of climate change. STFC's science is highly energy intensive, and we are one of the largest emitters of carbon for UKRI, STFC makes up over 40% of UKRI's total carbon emissions.

Its been identified that STFC's scope 2 (electricity) makes up about 75% of STFC's total carbon emissions. Our science and research are therefore the biggest focus area for us to decarbonise.

STFC's Executive Board has recently approved a project to identify areas across the science and research practises and operations to decarbonise. The Board require the development of an STFC wide environmental sustainability strategy including a carbon reduction pathway for our science, technical, and operations part of our organisation, to support UKRI reach our net zero target by 2040. The timeline for this is December 2024.

Scope of Works

- STFC need support with **scoping**, **planning** and **technical** advice to maximise the efficiency and effectiveness of STFC's research.
- Carbon advisory services carbon advise to actively explore ways to enhance the sustainability and decarbonisation of our research practices, methodologies and operations and providing the technical strategic direction.
- Provide technical understanding of the carbon reduction requirements of large technical facilities like STFC to ultimately reduce the carbon footprint of the UK's major research endeavours.
- Foresight and facilitation and engagement with technical staff to fully understand the requirements and what is possible for the science to decarbonise.
- Provide a framework and strategic direction for STFC to decarbonise the science.
- Meticulously assess the environmental impacts, and ensure compliance with appropriate regulatory requirement i.e. Greening Government Commitments
- Identify and recommend additional environmental benefits in the performance of STFC science including working towards net zero greenhouse gas emissions.

Deliverables

- Foresight, facilitation and engagement with Executives, Directors, technical and other staff to fully understand the requirements and what is possible for the science and operations to decarbonise.
- Provide strategic priorities and direction for STFC to decarbonise the science and operations which will help STFC's transition to net zero.
- Provide a strategic framework for environmental sustainability including decarbonisation.
- Offer technical advice as well as insights and learnings from other decarbonisation strategy projects.

Timeframe

- Scoping, planning, engagement and facilitation work needs to start immediately to deliver this piece of work by early December.
- Finalised strategic framework to be delivered to Exec Board in December 2024 Exec Board session.
